European Questionnaire regarding Health and Safety Conditions in the Commerce Sector

EuroCommerce and UNI Europa, social partners in the commerce sector, decided to undertake a study on the health, safety and well-being of retail and wholesale employees in their sector.

The main objectives of the project are to raise awareness of health and safety issues specific to the retail and wholesale sector and exchange experience and good practices related to implementing EU Health and Safety directives in the sector.

The study is focused on three main themes: ergonomics (mainly muscular skeletal disorders), stress at work (work-related stress including absenteeism, turnover and physical stress) and psychological risks (including third party violence and mental health risks). Its methodology is mainly based on the analysis of a survey carried out amongst UNI Europa affiliates and EuroCommerce members.

The following questionnaire has been sent to EuroCommerce members. The intention is to gather basic information from all European Member states in order to make a comparative study. The purpose of the questionnaire will also be to identify innovative and exemplary projects which will lead to a subsequent in depth study.

One of the main aims of the project is to elaborate a tool-kit based on good practices identified for each main theme. It is therefore of particular importance that you contact a selected and small number of companies (no more than three per country), preferably as varied as possible in terms of size (number of employees/turnout) and business type (food/non-food/fashion/distribution centre, etc.) that have developed particularly interesting initiatives to address health and safety issues. Please note that companies that will fill out the questionnaire will only give information on their companies and not on the sector in general.

This questionnaire is divided into seven parts:

- An association identification sheet which will enable us to get in touch with you for additional information:
- A first section on socio-economic indicators;
- A second section on work organisation and working conditions;
- A third section on health and safety information in the sector;
- A fourth section on health and safety sector regulations;
- A fifth section on good practices in the sector;
- A sixth section on innovative activities.
