## "ELPIDA" Philanthropic Foundation for Children with Cancer and Leukaemia

"ELPIDA" is a philanthropic foundation for children with cancer and leukaemia in Cyprus. It was created in 1991 by doctors, nurses, parents, scientists and friends of children who suffer from these very serious life threatening diseases. Its mission is to help in any possible way the child with cancer.

A significant and important work has been done till today in favour of these children and their families:

- 1. Continuous moral, psychological, social and financial help to the children and their families.
- 2. Purchase of modern equipment for the Paediatric Oncology-Haematology Clinic at the Makarios Hospital in Nicosia, which is the unique centre of reference in Cyprus for the diagnosis and treatment of children with cancer.
- 3. The ELPIDA Foundation has built and equipped the laboratories for bone marrow transplantation and diagnosis for leukaemia in the Makarios Hospital.
- 4. The ELPIDA Foundation has built just beside the Makarios Hospital the "ELPIDA" Hostel, which is a home and a refuge for the children and their families during the difficult and dangerous long periods of treatment and hospitalisation.
- Support and financing for the continuous education of all professionals involved: A number
  of nurses of the Paediatric Oncology Clinic as well as doctors of various specialisations and other
  scientists are sent abroad by ELPIDA to participate to international congresses or for further
  training.
- 6. Organisation in Cyprus of international seminars and congresses.
- 7. ELPIDA since 1992 supports and finances the research in Cyprus for Paediatric cancer and leukaemia.
- 8. **Therapeutic Recreation Programs:** Therapeutic recreation is very important for the support of the child, his or hers siblings and the rest of the family. Therefore ELPIDA finances and organises therapeutic recreation programs in Cyprus and abroad and it sends every year 5 to 10 children and adolescents to the Barretstown Gang Camp, which was created by Paul Newman in Ireland.
